## **Check-ins & Playtime (OUTSIDE)**

### **Snack**

Pass out a cup of Goldfish crackers (Chex available for gluten and dairy free) Encourage them not to eat until after you have prayed.

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## “Lollipops and Lemons” & Prayer Requests

- While eating, ask your class if anyone had any “Lollipops” (good things that happened) or “Lemons” (bad things that happened) from this last week.
  - Lollipops - immediately thank God!
  - Lemons - immediately ask if someone would like to pray for their friend’s “lemon.” Model short, one-sentence prayers.

**NOTE: This time gives kids a chance to learn that praying for someone is easy and doesn’t have to sound fancy. There’s power in their prayers too!**

## **Bible Skills (IN TWO GROUPS)**

9:05 - 9:15 \ \ 11:20 - 11:30

Help your kids locate the scripture below, mark it with the ribbon bookmark, and bring their bibles to Large Group

**John 11:1, 3-7, 17, 20-29, 32-35, 38-39, 41-45**

To encourage those who are new to class or who are not yet comfortable with finding a scriptures in the Bible, please slowly instruct your kids on how to find the verse. Please DO NOT make this a competition unless you know for sure all the kids in your class have mastered this skill.

Training Tips:

1. Remind kids there are two parts in the Bible: the Old Testament and the New Testament. Each Testament contains multiple books. Each book is divided into chapters. Each chapter is divided into verses.
2. At the start of each Bible is a table of contents.
  - Show them how they can look for the book in the table of contents to find the page number.
  - Once they find the page number they can turn to that page, look for the chapter, and then the verse.
3. Over time they will eventually grow more comfortable and may not need the table of contents anymore.
