Big Picture Question: How is Jesus the perfect Prophet?

Technology Instructions (set up when you arrive)

1. Turn on the TV using the remote.
2. Turn on the iPad (Password: 1954)
3. Mirror the iPad to the TV.
 - Using your finger, swipe from the top right corner, diagonally to the center of the screen.
 - Select “Screen Mirroring”
 - Select “three-and-four-year-old-room”
4. Select “Google Slides” and find the current preschool lesson (they are dated)
5. Select “Present to external display”
6. The slides for the lesson should now clearly be seen on the TV. On the iPad, select “next” to move to the next slide. You might also need to select “Play Video”

Check-ins | Welcome families and receive kids as they arrive. Remind the parents that their child’s safety is our highest priority. For the safety of their child, we must see their Security Label at pick-up, and if their child needs them before the service ends, we will TEXT them.

1. Have kids sit around the tables and pass out a cup of Goldfish crackers (Chex are available for those who are gluten and dairy free), a cup of water, and a napkin to each 3 & 4 year old. Encourage them not to eat until after you have prayed.
2. Invite a child to pray for the food.
3. Enjoy!

Circle Time

Welcome Song

Gather on the carpet and sing “Who Came to Church Today”

“Who Came to Church Today” lyrics

Who came to church today, church today, church today?
Who came to church today?
What’s your name?

Point to a child, allow them to answer, and then everyone greets them saying
“Hi ___!”

Introduce the Story (2 mins)

1. Open in prayer.
2. Hold up the Bible and tell the kids that today’s story is true and it is found in the Bible

Watch the Story Video (3-4 mins)

Retell the Story (3-4 mins)

Using the numbered storytelling images and reading prompts, retell the story to the preschoolers.

Discussion Questions (3-4 mins)

- What did you like about today’s story?
- What did we learn about God
- Why did Jesus say the religious leaders were like snakes?

Memory Verse Song (3 mins)

Lead the preschoolers through the key passage song in the slide show.

Worship (8-10 mins)

Lead the preschoolers in worship using the prepared songs in the slide show.

Craft

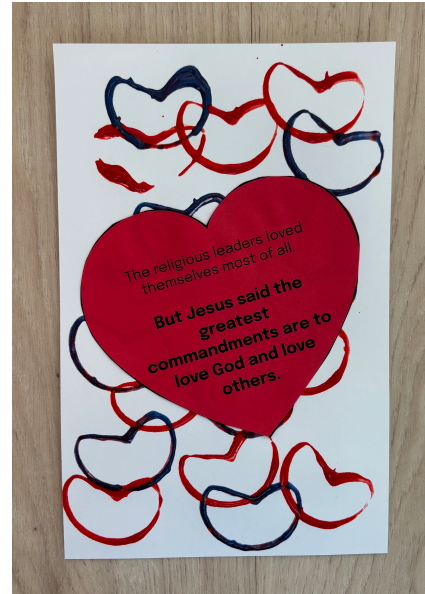
Greatest Commandment Craft

Supplies:

- 1/2 sheet of white card stock
- Craft tube heart stamp
- Paper plate (2-3 per table)
- Washable Paint
- Heart cutout
- Glue sticks

Instructions:

1. **In our lesson, we learned about how the pharisees loved themselves most of all, but Jesus said the two greatest commandments are to love God and love others. Because of Jesus, we can do that!**
2. Pass out the card stock and one stamp per kid. Squirt some paint options onto the paper plates. And set out about 2-3 per table for the kids to share.
3. Using their heart stamp made of the craft tube, have the kids put their stamp in the paint and then on their paper over and over again to create a bunch of hearts.
4. Pass out the Heart cutout and glue sticks. Have the kids put glue on the pack of their heart and place it on the card stock with the hearts as the background.
