to be saved?”**



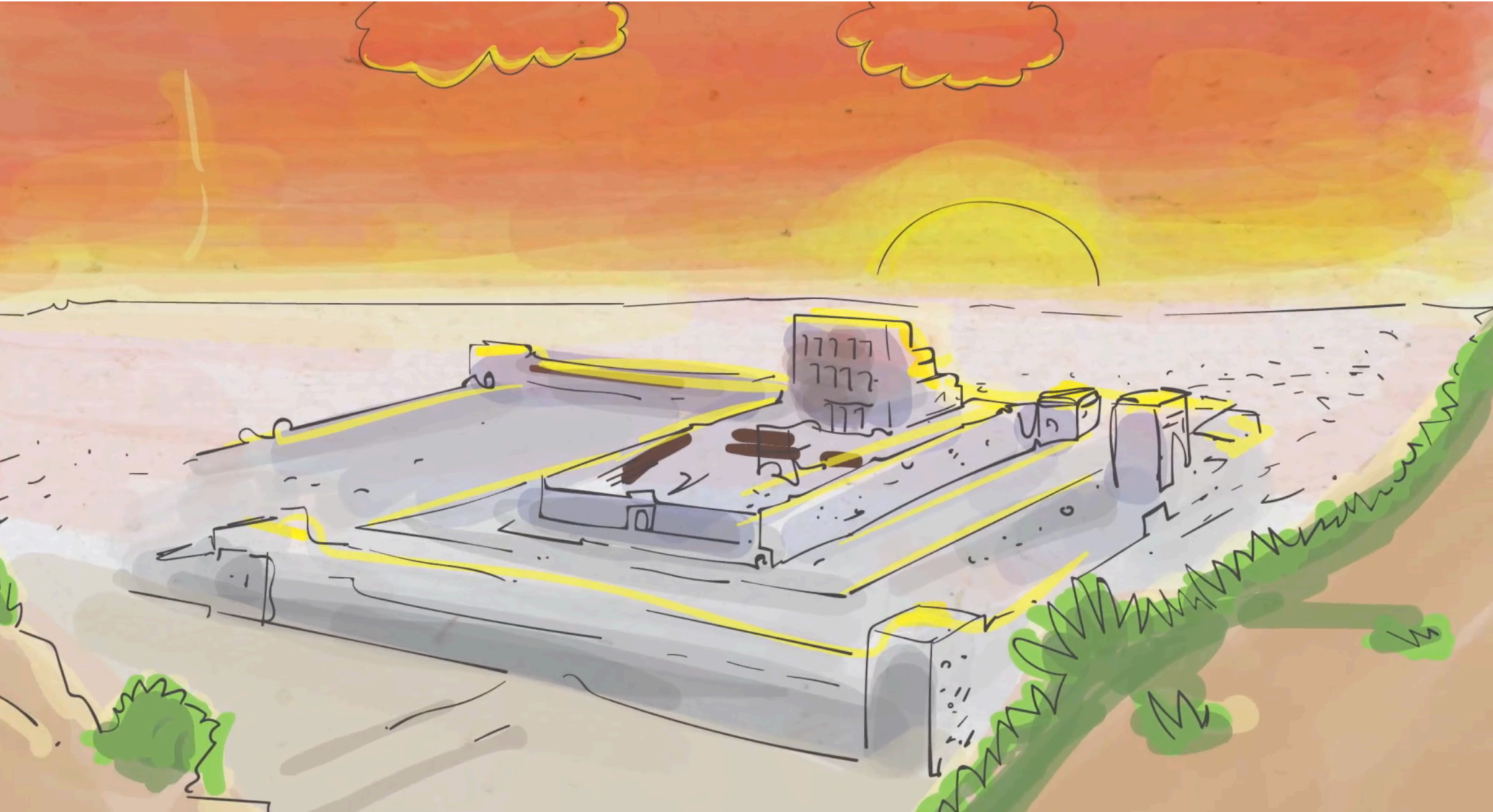
Jesus said, “Try to enter God’s kingdom. The path to heaven is like a narrow door. Many people will try to get in, but not many people will.”



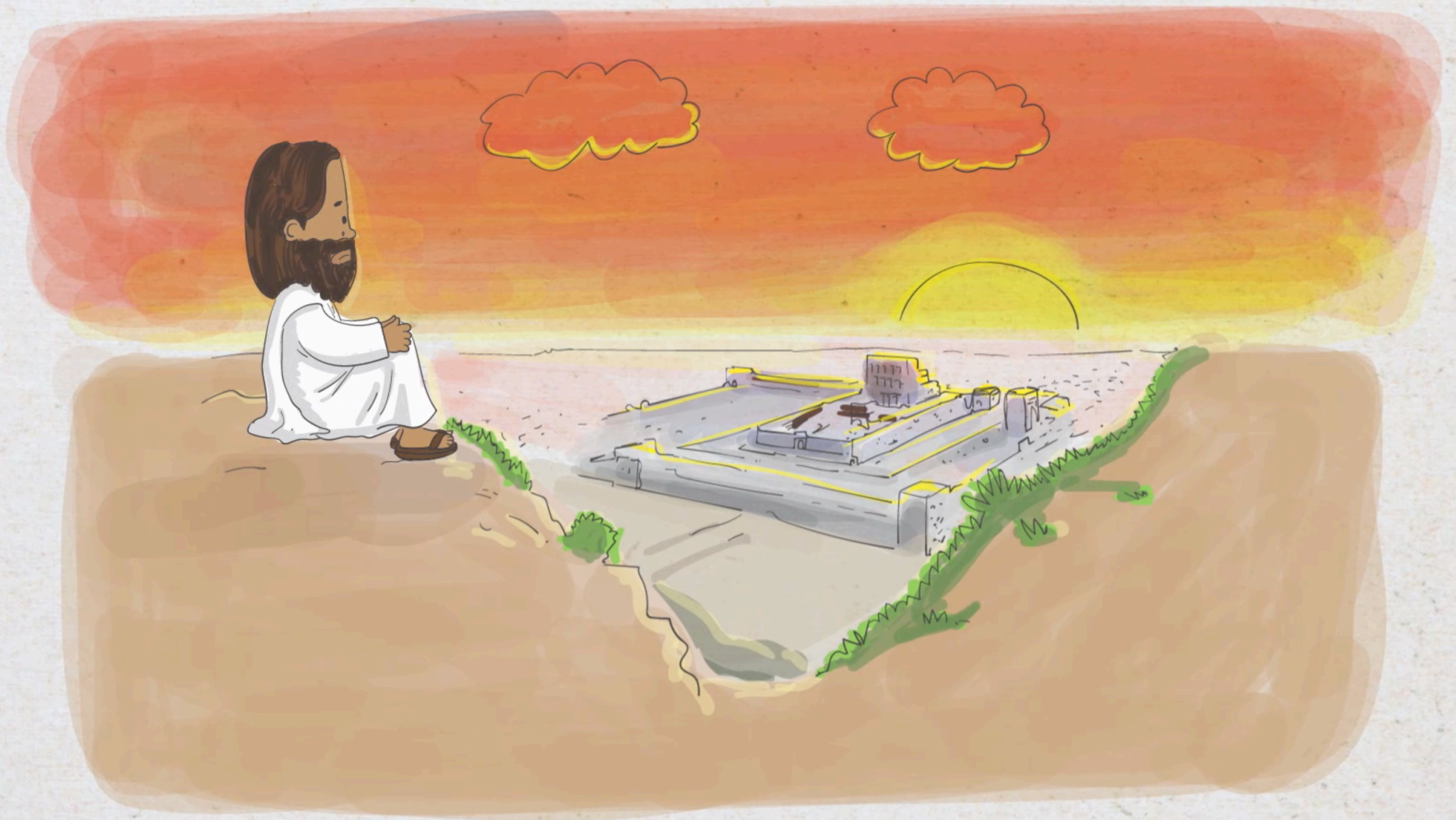
Jesus said that people must turn from their sins and trust in Jesus to be saved.



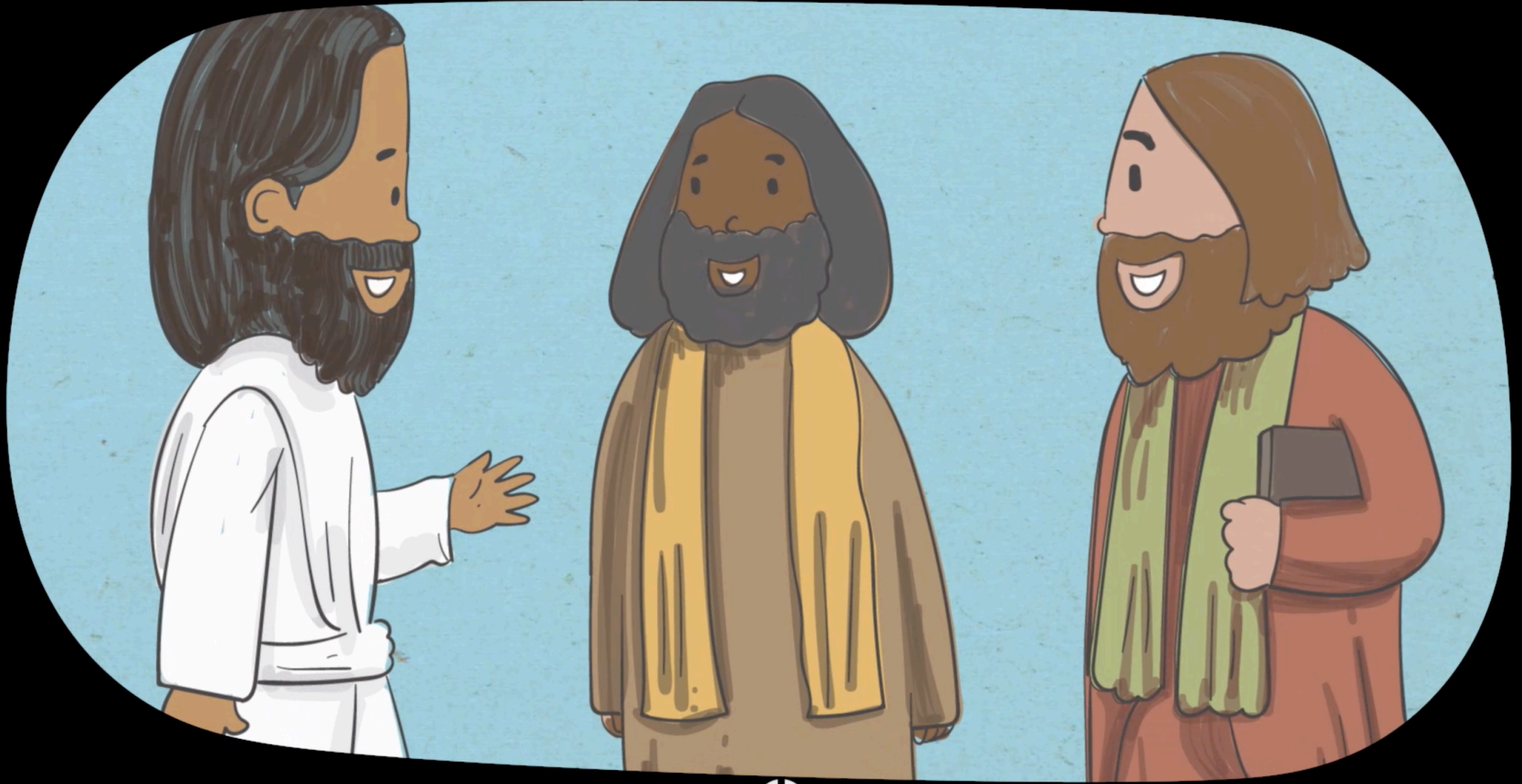
Then some religious leaders came to Jesus. They said, “You need to leave. Herod wants to hurt You.”
