



**Paul wrote a letter to Christians in Ephesus. He said that following Jesus is like fighting a battle. God gives people who believe in Jesus everything they need to fight against evil. “Put on the armor of God,” he said. “Be ready.”**



**Paul said, “Truth is like a belt.” We know what is true because God tells us about Himself in the Bible. He gives us righteousness, like armor on your chest, when we trust in Jesus.**





**Paul told them to always be ready to tell others about Jesus—like sandals on your feet. He said, “Faith is like a shield; it will protect you.” God gives us faith to help us trust in Him.**



**“Salvation is like your helmet, and the Bible, God’s Word, is like your sword.” A helmet protects your head. And God’s Word tells us what is true.**





**Finally, Paul said, “Pray for God’s people, and pray for me. Pray that God will help me when I tell others about Jesus.”**
