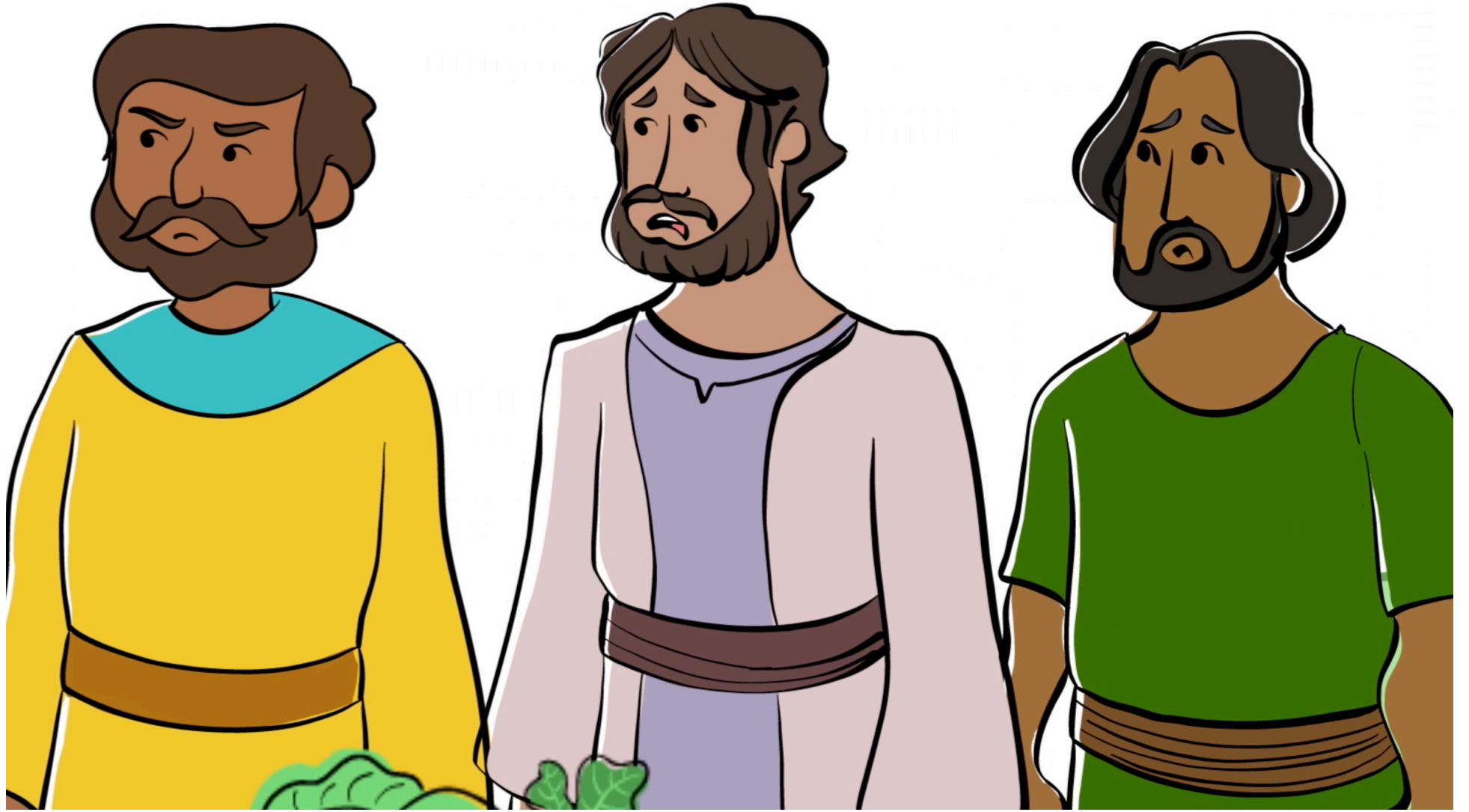


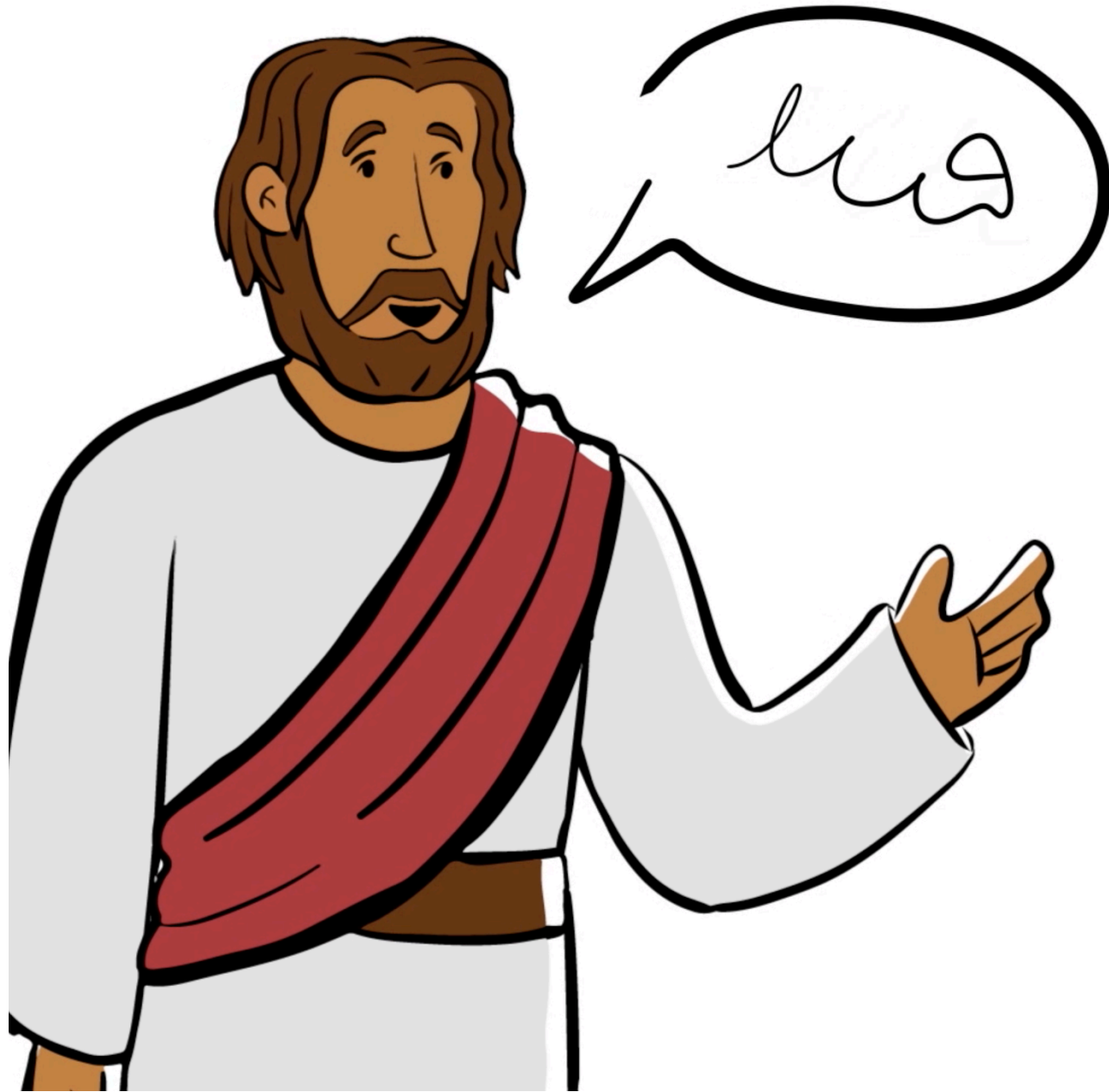
Before the Passover feast, Jesus went to a friend's house for a meal.
