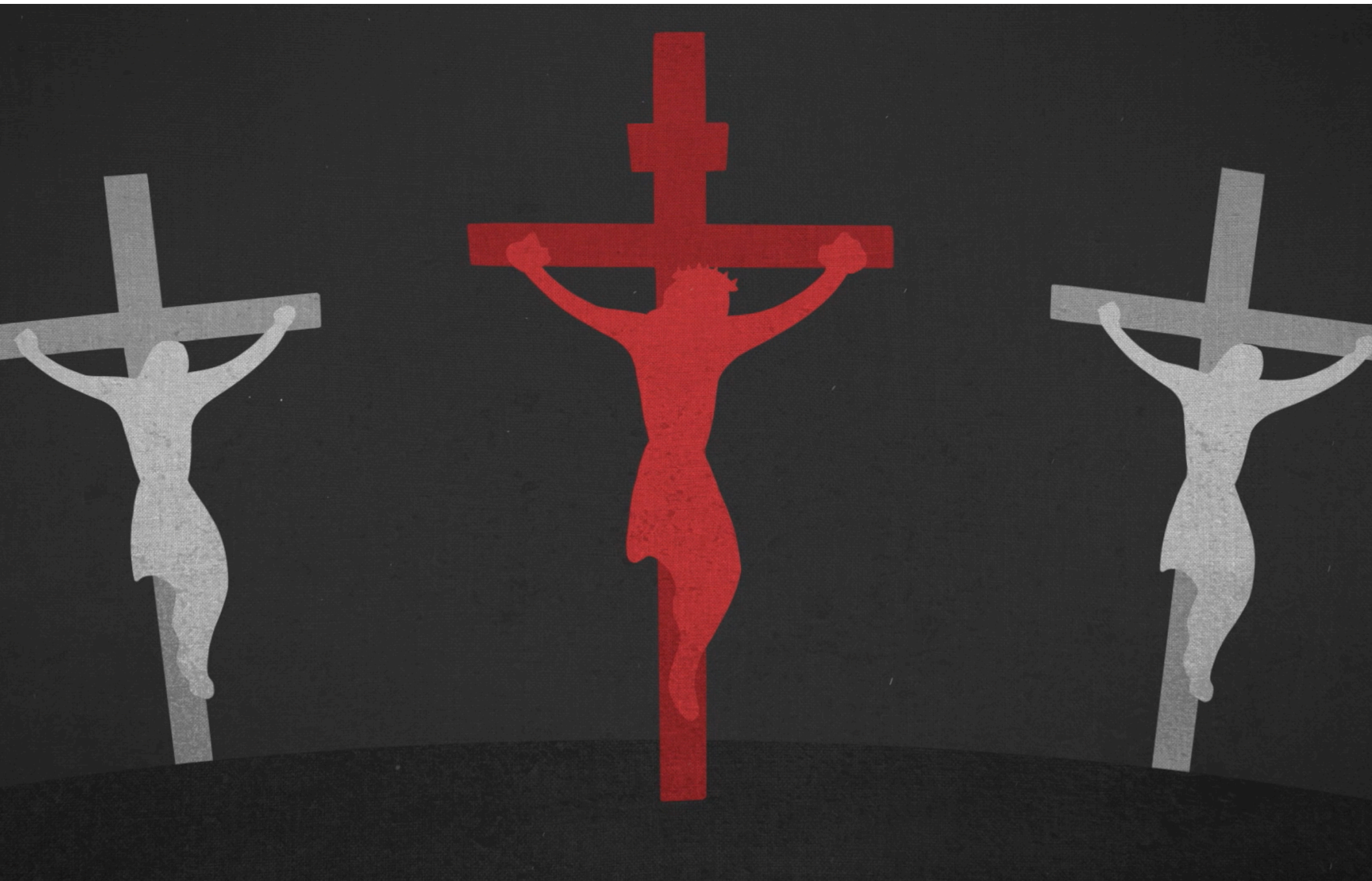




Soldiers took Jesus away. They made fun of Him and put a crown of thorns on Jesus' head and a purple robe on His back. They pretended to bow down to Him.
