**The man told them to put their fishing nets into the water on the right side of the boat. The friends did, and they caught so many fish!**

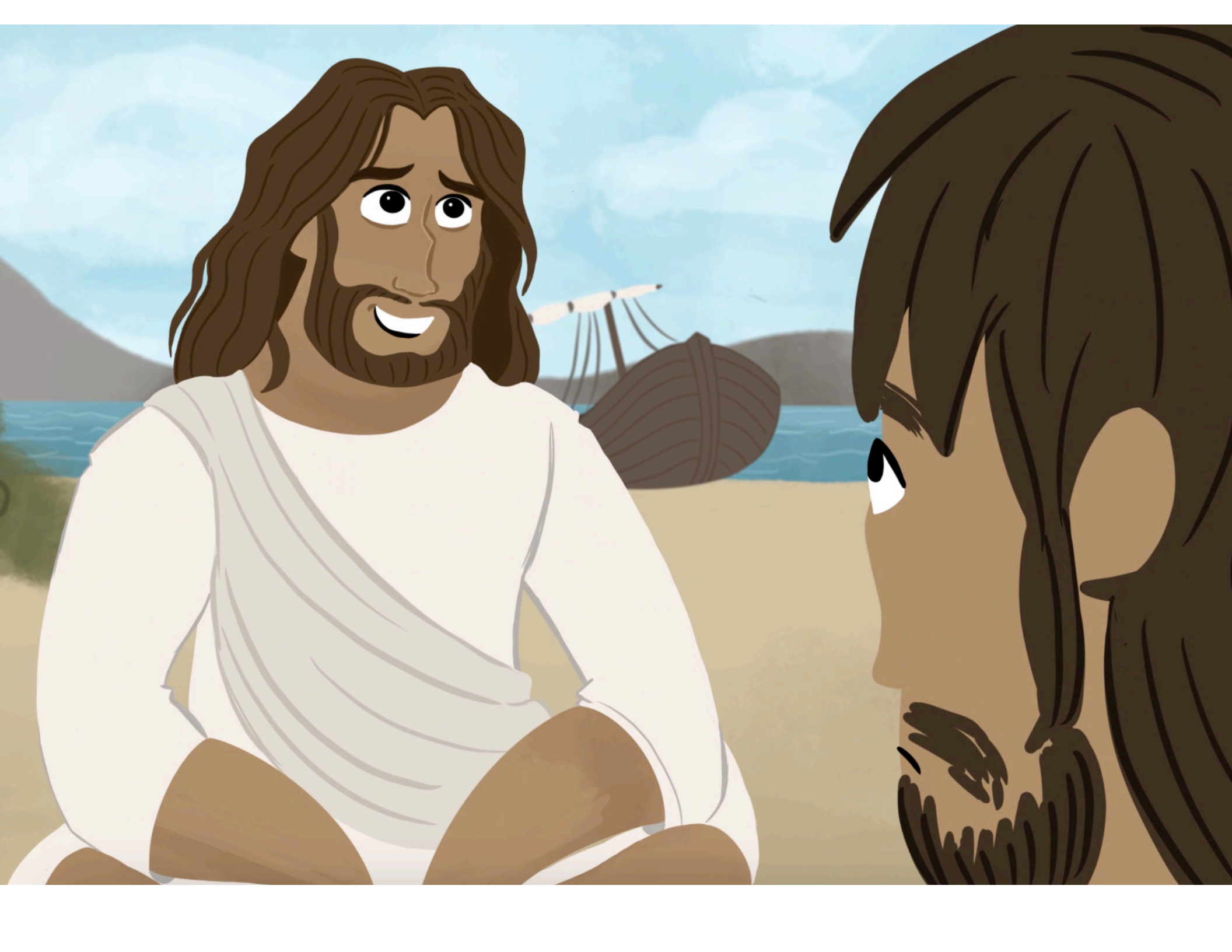


**The friends saw that the man was Jesus. Peter swam to shore and the other friends came in the boat. Jesus invited the friends to eat breakfast with Him.**
