Line up the kids and grab the clipboard

As they are in line, explain that we are going to be going into the sanctuary to worship Jesus and watch the baptisms. Baptism is something people do to show the world that they have decided to follow Jesus. It's an outward expression of how Jesus has changed them on the inside.

Go to the sanctuary and bring the clipboard

DO NOT ENTER until the worship music has started. When the music starts, lead the kids down aisle to the carpets at the front.

Worship and Baptisms

The kids are free to worship and celebrate the people being baptized. Please keep the kids together.

Parents might want to pick-up their kids early (some are even getting baptized!), and that is okay. Don't forget to check the security label, matching them to the child's name tag, and have them sign out on the clipboard.

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Go back outside

As soon as worship ends, lead the kids out of the double doors on the right side of the sanctuary closest to the stage. Lead the kids to the outdoor space through the double doors outside this hallway. FOR SAFETY REASONS, DO NOT LET THE KIDS GET PICKED-UP OR CHECKED OUT DURING THIS TRANSITION.

Check-out

Check the guardian receipts, matching them to the child's name tag, and have them sign out on the clipboard.
