



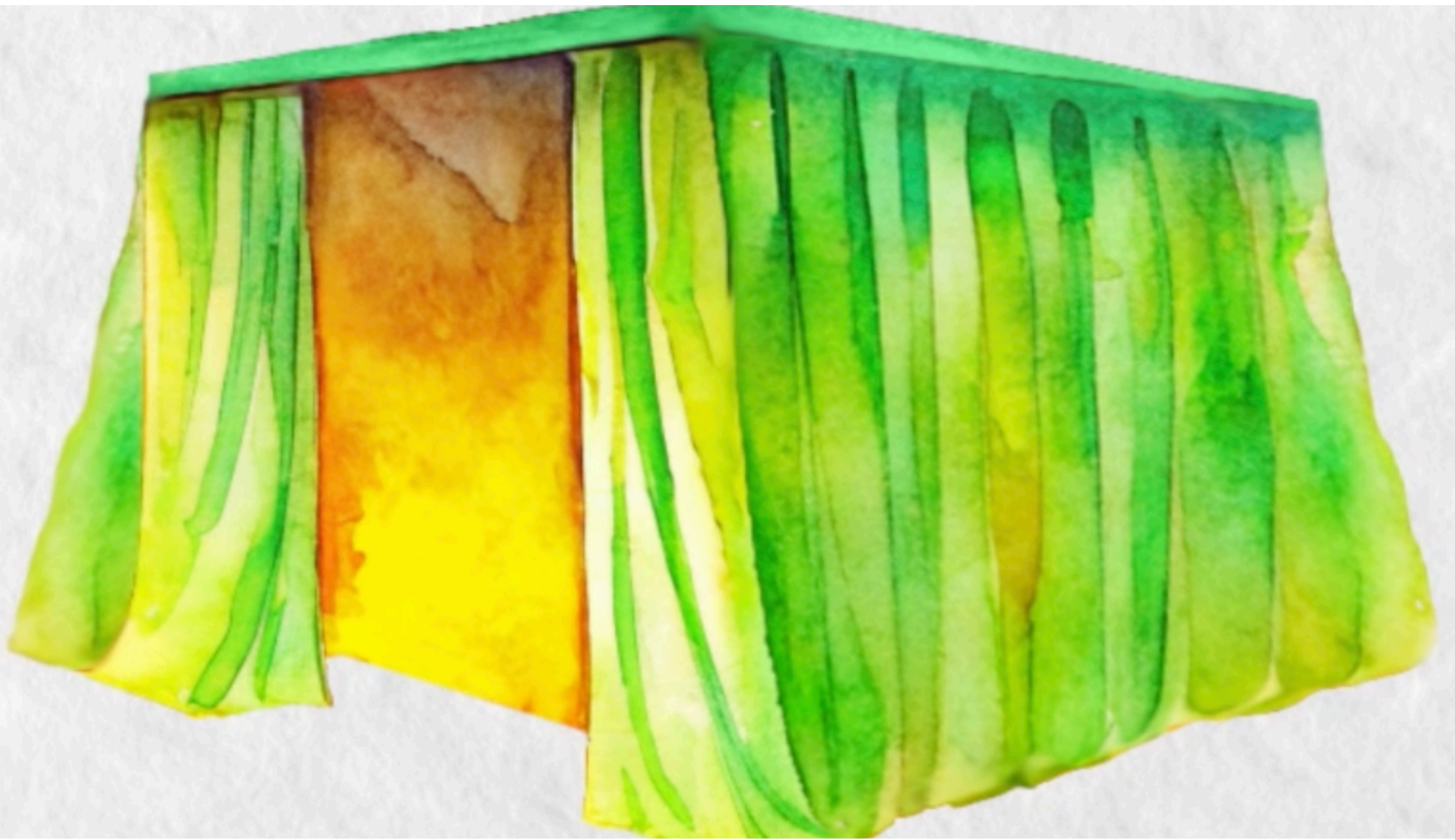
God's people worked together to make a special building called a tabernacle.
