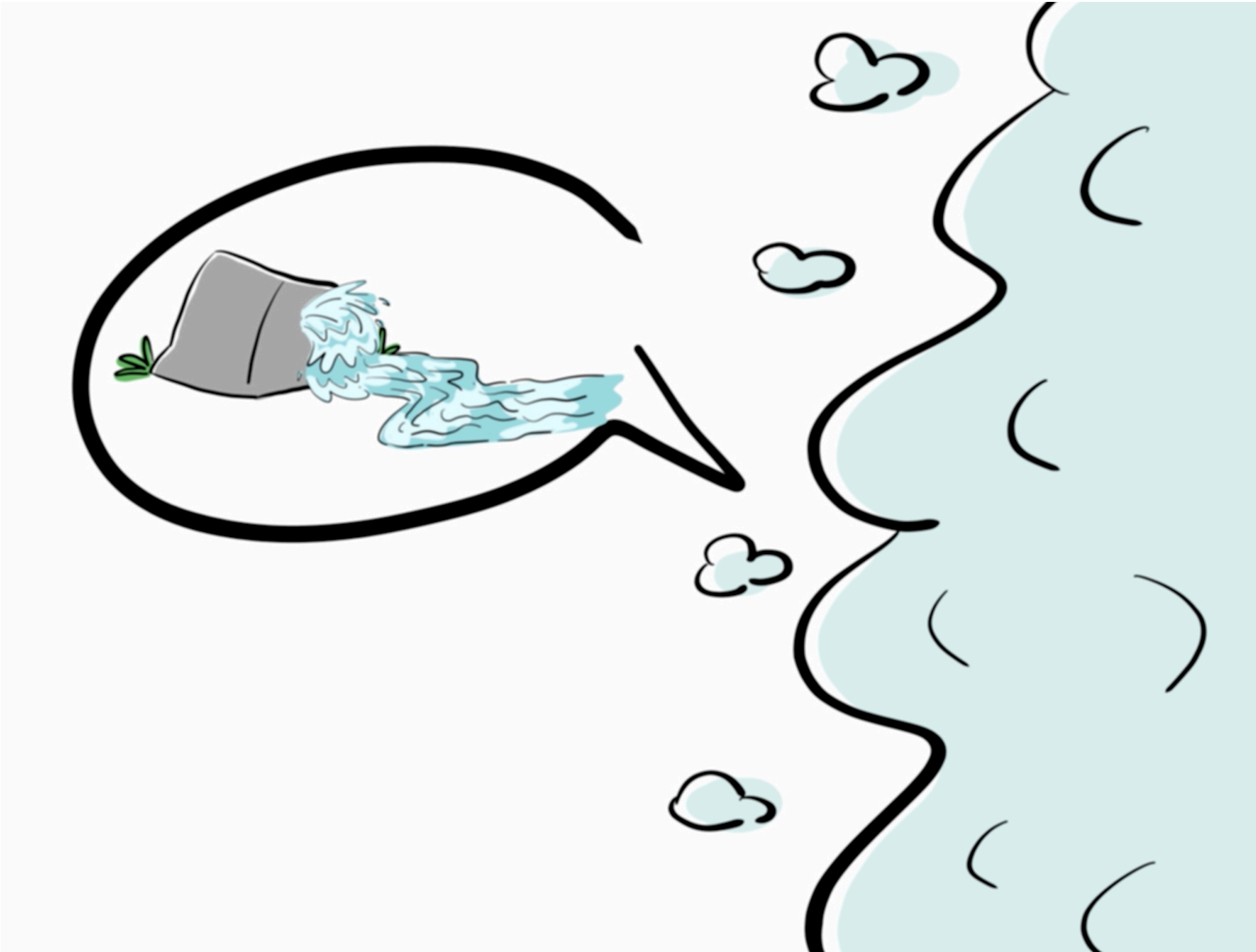
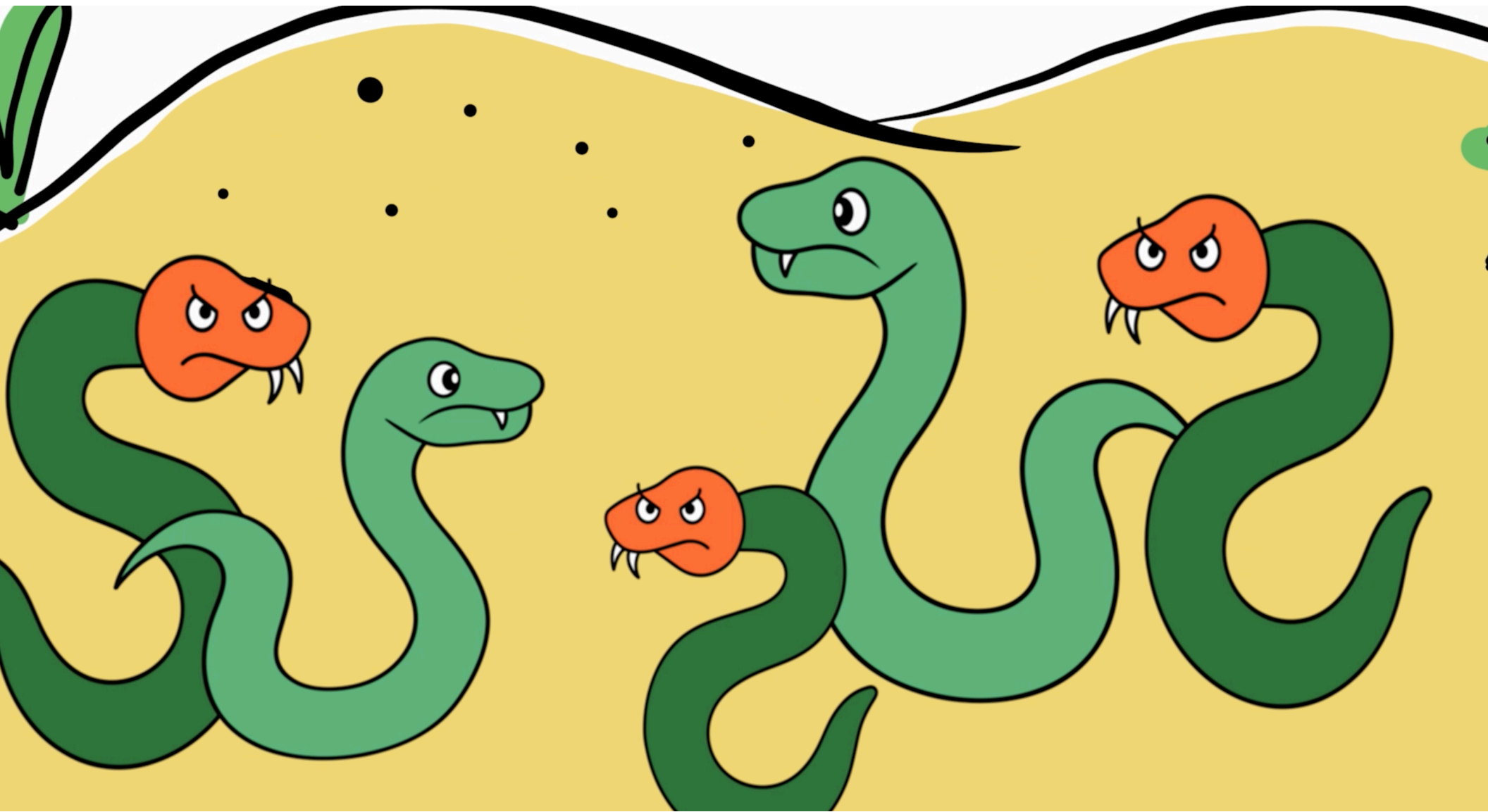




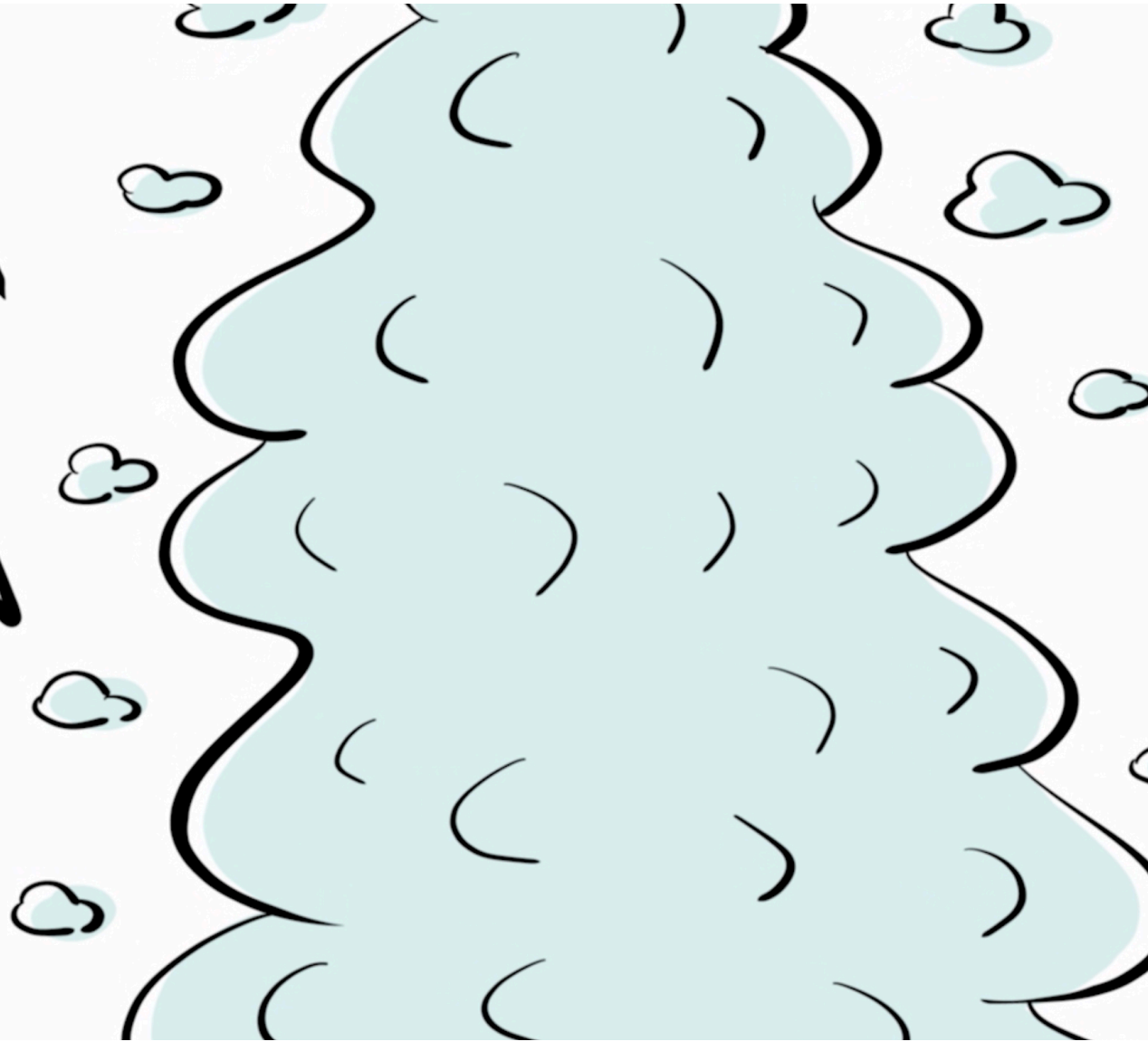
**God's people had to walk in the wilderness for 40 years. They complained a lot.**
