The disciples were very upset and asked "Am I the one? Who is he talking about?"

Judas then asks "Am I the one?" And Jesus said "You have said it."

Soon after, Judas left to betray Jesus.



Preschool Christ Connection: God made a covenant, or agreement, with His people long ago. The people promised to love and obey God, and He promised to be their God. Sadly, God's people broke the covenant. God sent Jesus to make a new, even better covenant. God would forgive people for their sins, and God would help them obey Him.

- 3. What did Jesus say the bread was like? (His body)
- 4. What did Jesus say the cup was like? (His blood)
- 5. What did Jesus do to save us? Jesus died on the cross and rose from the dead

Elementary Christ Connection: Jesus showed His disciples with the bread and the drink that He is the true Passover Lamb. God's people had broken the old covenant, and God promised to make a new covenant to forgive sins. The new covenant says that everyone who turns away from sin and trusts in Jesus' death and resurrection will be forgiven of his sins and will have eternal life.
