

High School Sequoia Sessions 2022

July 7th-10th (\$60 for 3 nights!)

For all new 9th, 10th, 11th, 12th graders and 2022 graduates



Your High School student is invited to join us for wilderness camping on a secluded meadow in the Giant Sequoia National Monument.

The Sequoia Sessions trip is an opportunity for your student to worship and grow in relationship with the Lord as they explore Giant Sequoia groves, wild river valleys and ponder the majesty of God around a campfire beneath a million stars. We will hike into Sequoia groves and wilderness meadows, summit a granite dome and swim in mountain river. All this as students worship, work, and grow into a Jesus-centered community.

DETAILS

Cost:

- **9th through 12th grade trip is \$60 (3 night trip)****
 - Price Includes water bottle, headlamp, flashlight, meals at camp, tent, transportation, and activities.
 - We will stop for lunch on our way up & back. Please send an extra \$20 to cover both meals.
 - **Space is limited to just 30 students per trip!**

Check-In: 8am at the youth warehouse.

Pick-Up: 4pm at the youth warehouse.

This is a WILDERNESS CAMPING trip:

- There is no cell service in the forest.
- Students will work to to set-up camp, prep & cook meals, clean, and learn fire safety/maintenance.
- Temps range from 90° daytime to 35° at night.
- RAIN can happen unexpectedly at anytime!
- Elevation at camp is 7,100'
- Students are encouraged to bring a pocket knife. Safe knife practices will be taught & enforced.

PACKING

What to bring:

- Bible
- Notepad/Journal
- Pen/Pencil
- \$ for 2 meals on the road
- Warm sleeping bag (30°)
- Headlamp/Flashlight (opt)
- Daypack for hiking
- Hiking clothes (warm days)
- Jacket for cold evenings
- Swimsuit
- Towel
- Hiking Shoes (sneakers ok)
- Water shoes (separate pair)
- Socks
- Toiletries
- Sunscreen
- Lip balm (Chapstick)
- Bug Repellent
- Pocket knife up to 4" blade

What NOT to bring:

- Drugs, Alcohol, Weapons, Fireworks, matches/lighter/any other fire starter, or anything that doesn't glorify God.

A note about pocket knives:

- Knives are a necessary tool in the wilderness and students are encouraged to bring a folding knife with a blade up to 4" long. Safe knife practices will be taught & enforced.

Packing Notes:

- **Pack in luggage that won't tear (no garbage bags).**
- **Label all luggage with students name.**

Medications:

- All medication should be marked clearly with student's name, placed in a ziplock bag with clear instructions, and given to a leader at check-in.
